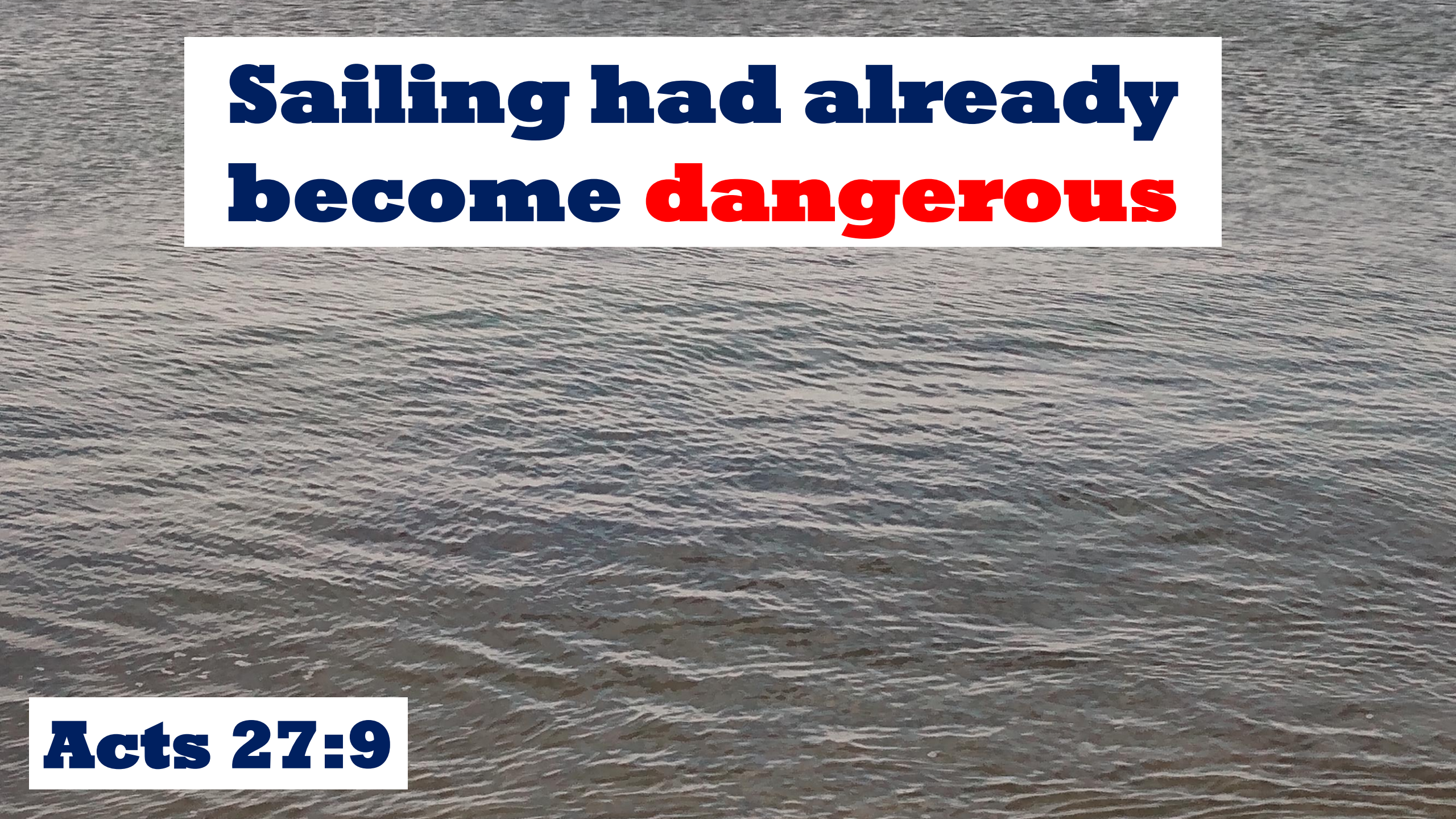


Even an apostle has needs

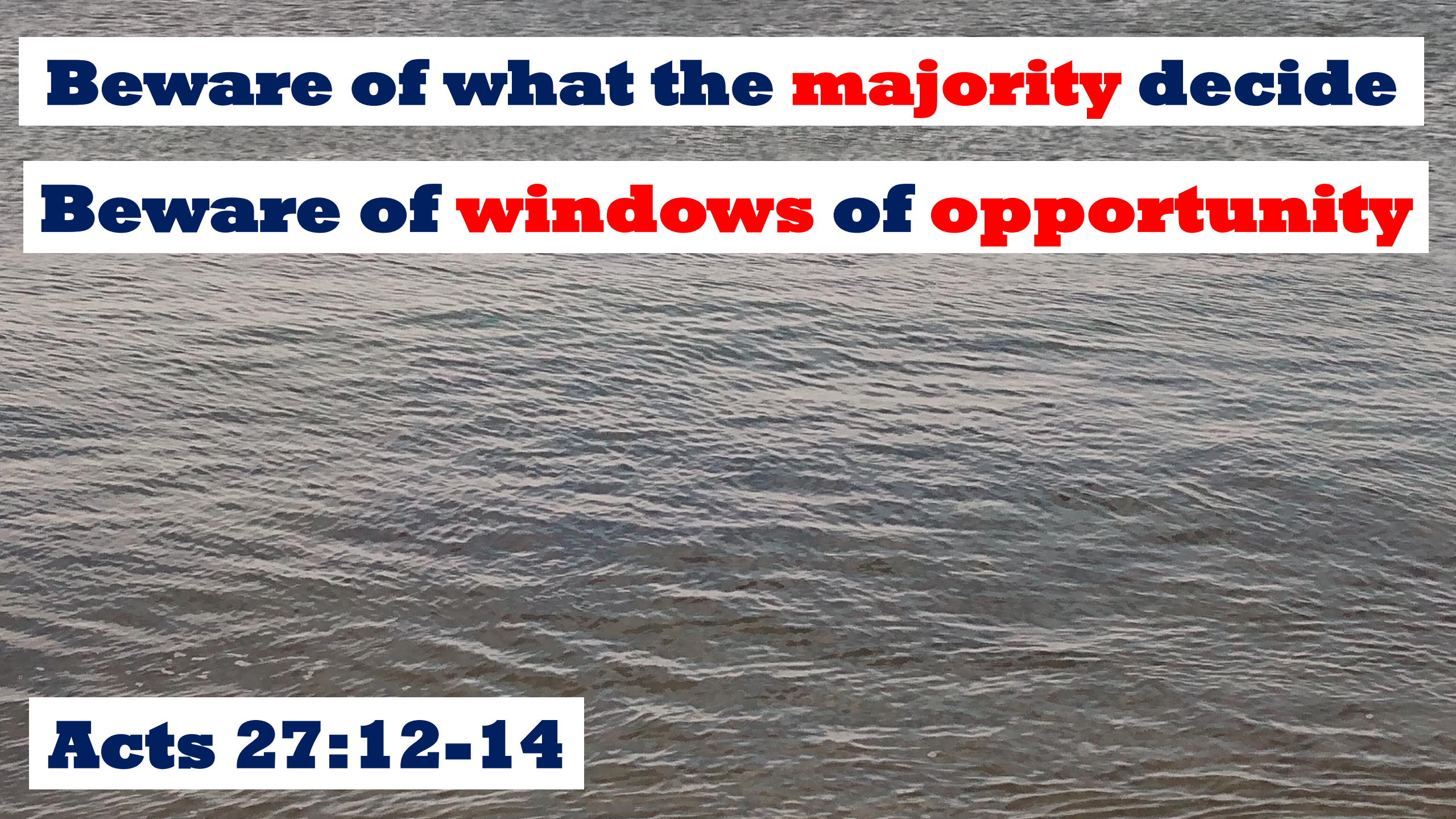
**Sailing had already

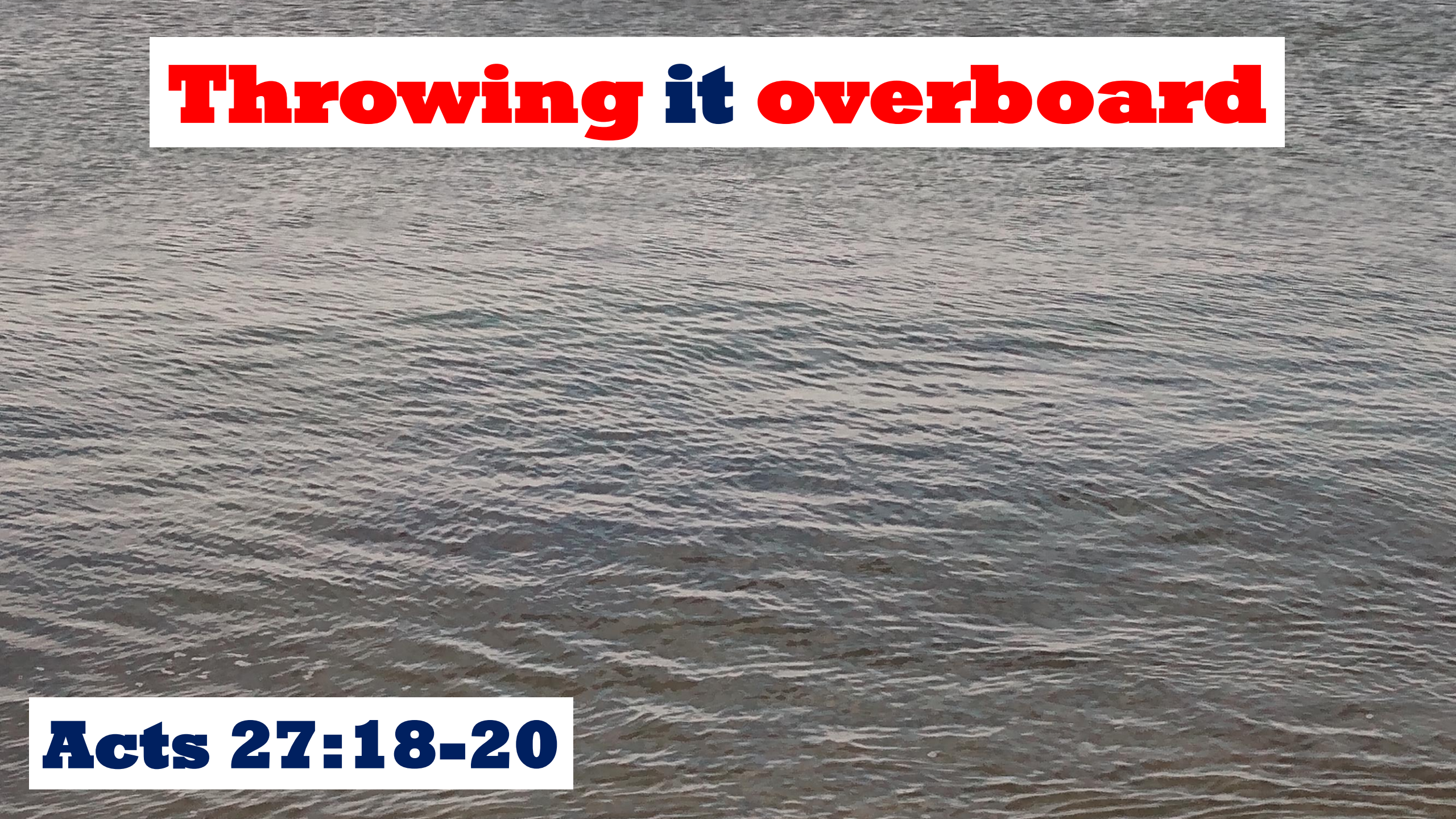
Beware of windows of opportunity

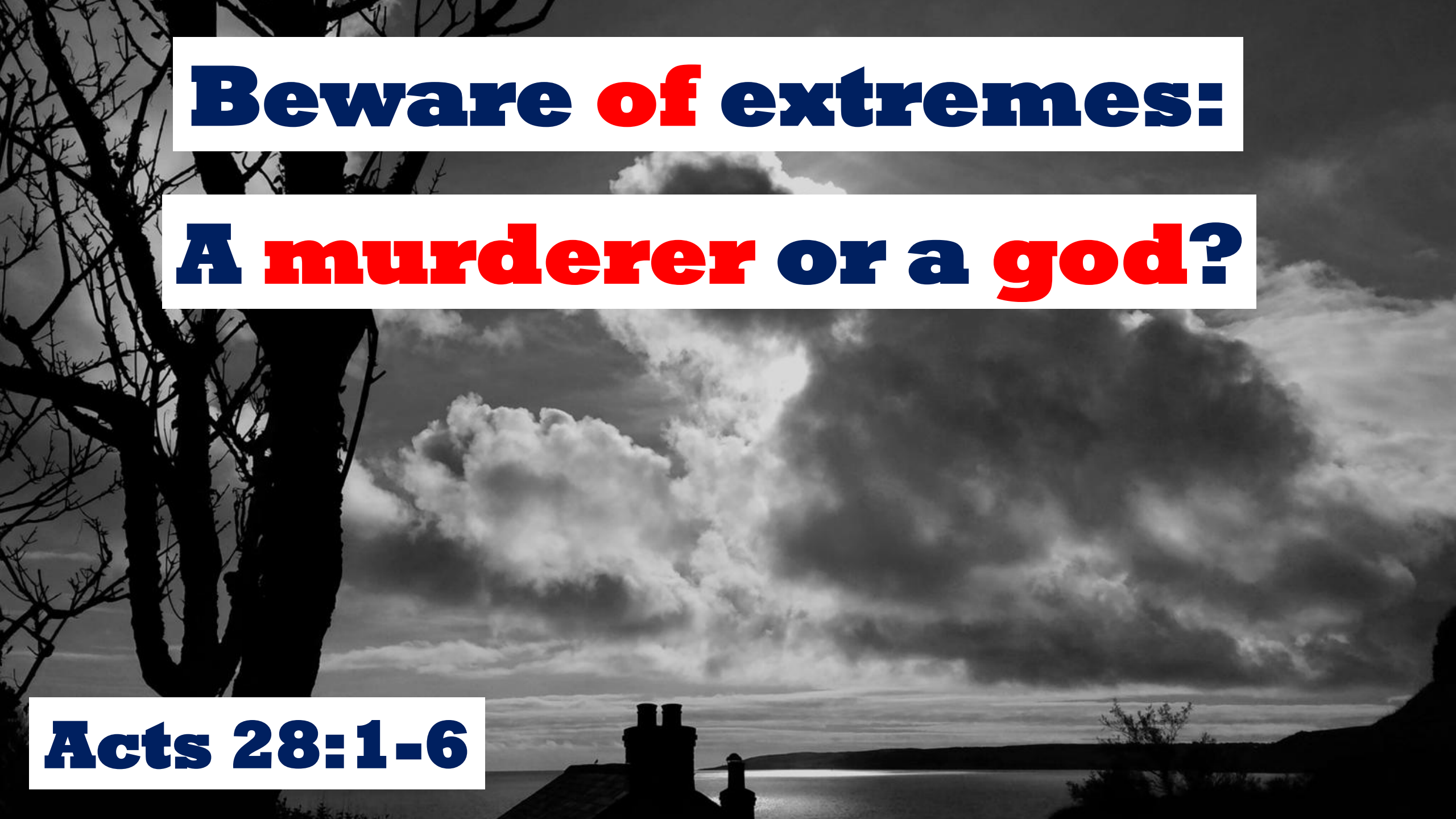
